
Australian Federation of Ukrainian Organisation (AFUO) Humanitarian Aid Initiatives Committee (HAIC)

- Establish need and source solution and complete due diligence on all projects / assistance
- AFUO HAIC Chair makes recommendation to the AFUO board for sanctioning and authorisation of funding
- AFUO HAIC request RAWCS for release of donated funds for the nominated project or aid

Our RAWCS project managers work closely with us and provide advice and support of programs.

Meetings are held at least monthly with all stakeholders to track progress and assure the projects still satisfy current needs.

Dimensions of the Conflict in Ukraine

When soldiers return home the conflict remains within

Russian aggression in Ukraine's Crimean Peninsula and eastern Ukraine has inflicted an immeasurable cost on the civilian population in Ukraine. *The London-based Ukrainian Information Service has compiled the following statistics based on official sources (such as the UNHCR, OCHA and UNICEF). It is worth remembering:*

- 14,000 thousand death toll
- 1.5 million people internally displaced
- 3.4 million people in need of humanitarian assistance
- 1.5 million elderly in need
- 510,00 children growing up surrounded by violence
- Over 750 education facilities damaged by shelling
- 50,000 homes damaged or destroyed
- 530,000 people are food insecure
- One in four persons in eastern Ukraine suffer water shortages
- Over 100 Ukrainian political prisoners held hostage by Russia
- 5th globally for casualties caused by landmines
- 420 kilometre 'contact line' leaving millions facing severe restrictions

A full-fledged war is STILL being fought in Eastern Ukraine

- Over 397,000 veterans due to the war caused by Russian aggression
- Over 10,000 killed and tens of thousand injured

Many have injuries that will never fully heal - chronic phantom pains from amputations, burns covering much of their bodies, extensive brain damage.

In addition, many Ukrainian soldiers returning home suffer from psychological trauma. Addiction and alcoholism. And their problems are not getting the attention they deserve.

More assistance is urgently required in conflict-affected areas.

MAKING A DIFFERENCE



Ukraine Crisis Appeal was established in 2015 after Russia invaded Ukraine

- 2015 \$57,000 was raised for provisioning of urgently required life saving medical equipment to war zone hospitals. Donation of equipment was sourced and only what was not sourced was paid for.

2018 the AFUO Humanitarian Aid Initiative Committee was formed and actively have raised funds to date

SYDNEY INVICTUS GAMES OCTOBER 2018 CAMPAIGN

- \$128,000 was raised to create a better life for the war's veterans

“2019/20 Veterans Aid program”

- Life changing support and rehabilitation of 24 Veterans, with 52 of their families as indirect beneficiaries, including 36 children
- Through addiction rehabilitation, PTS rehabilitation, medical aids, legal assistance, retraining for employment, education, improvement of living conditions & self-esteem. Most are now, employed and families have been reunited under one roof

2021 "Occupational Therapy training program"

collaboration of Curtin University WA & Ukrainian Catholic University, Lviv and The Ukrainian Ergotherapy (Occupational) Therapy Society for which additional funds were raised

OT is in its infancy in Ukraine, this is the first OT program run for health workers and a "Train the trainer" program
Curtin University OT materials adapted and translated into Ukrainian with uniform condition and treatment titles
55 participants from over 20 institutions have completed 3 mth course | 8 OT professionals trained to repeat program in 2022

Graduates now have the skills to treat and improve the quality of life of patients. 440 -500 patients were being seen per day across Ukraine

2021 “Veterans Social Adaptions Program”

In collaboration with Caritas Ukraine and Nazaret Rehabilitation Centre was the result of understanding that substance or alcohol addition is one of the greatest demons of post war trauma and impacts the whole family

- 63 veterans and 30 wives are undergoing a specialist in-house rehabilitation program at Nazareth Rehab Centre
- 10 coaches will be identified and trained to commence a “Veteran Peer Support Groups”

Veteran’s are completing this program whilst Nazaret is also now housing 300 displaced persons. We are also helping to fund this.

With the expansion of russia's brutal aggression across Ukraine, the population is in crisis. People are injured, displaced and need urgent housing and humanitarian aid

The WHO health cluster estimates that the effected number of people is already over

18 million

IMPACT OF WAR SINCE 24.2.2022

24:00 midnight on 19 April 2022 (local time), the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) recorded 5,121 civilian casualties in Ukraine: 2,224 killed and 2,897 injured. This included:

- a total of 2,224 killed (631 men, 383 women, 42 girls, and 61 boys, as well as 70 children and 1,037 adults whose sex is yet unknown)
- a total of 2,897 injured (335 men, 271 women, 59 girls, and 64 boys, as well as 157 children and 2,011 adults whose sex is yet unknown)
- Most of the civilian casualties recorded were caused by the use of explosive weapons with a wide impact area, including shelling from heavy artillery and multiple launch rocket systems, and missile and air strikes.
- OHCHR believes that the actual figures are considerably higher, as the receipt of information from some locations where intense hostilities have been going on has been delayed and many reports are still pending corroboration. This concerns, for example, Mariupol (Donetsk region), Iziurm (Kharkiv region), Popasna (Luhansk region), and Borodianka (Kyiv region), where there are allegations of numerous civilian casualties. These figures are being further corroborated and are not included in the above statistics.

6.5 million people are displaced in Ukraine

73 days ago they slept safely at home in their own warm bed

Ukraine Crisis Appeal has provided \$1.25 million dollars in emergency aid

Being emergency shelters, housing, clean drinking water, food, clothing and medical assistance






Ukraine Crisis Appeal
